Muskeg Meadows Modifications

Course repairs on fairway #3 remain in effect. Beware of foot bridges, and areas that are roped off. Please note that the areas under construction are considered out of bounds, and may be played with a free drop, no closer to the pin. The yardage on that fairway has been modified and compensated for on fairway #6, changing #6 fairway to a par 4. During tournaments teams will be using the colored pegs for tee areas. Men use the white and ladies use the red pegs for a short par 3. On fairway #6 the champion boxes will be used by men and the white tee box will be used as the forward tee. The "Closest to the Pin" competition will remain on #4. The "Straightest Drive" has permanently been moved to fairway #1 from #5. The orange flag on #4 continues to remain under repair. The new driving range netting has arrived at the golf course and coordinating a work party for installation is underway.
