Muskeg Meadows Modifications

Course repairs on fairway #3 remain in effect. Beware of foot bridges, and areas that are roped off. Please note that the areas under construction are considered out of bounds. and may be played with a free drop, no closer to the pin. The vardage on that fairway has been modified and compensated for on fairway #6, changing #6 fairway to a par 4. During tournaments teams will be using the colored pegs for tee areas. Men use the white and ladies use the red pegs for a short par 3. On fairway #6 the champion boxes will be used by men and the white tee box will be used as the forward tee. The "Closest to the Pin" competition will remain on #4. The "Straightest Drive" has permanently been moved to fairway #1 from #5. The orange flag on #4 continues to remain under repair. Please use the yellow flag.

Jim Nelson and Tim Buness have generously donated their time to install electricity to the Tournament Room. Work is currently underway, and expected to be finished by Thursday, May 30th.
