- Enter handicap scores daily
- Assist with organization and implementation of tournaments.
- Assist with food service for tournaments, including, but not limited to, grocery shopping, cleaning food service cart and shelter before and after, and cooking or scheduling staff or volunteers to cook.
- Assist with maintaining order in the in the driving range and shed, making sure driving range rules are followed at all times.
